Warranty Policy

PART A — ENGINE WARRANTY

1. Warranty Scope

This warranty applies only to engines built or reconditioned by Racing Cars International Pty Ltd ("Hyper Racer"). Warranty coverage is strictly limited to defects in workmanship arising from the assembly, installation, or modification performed by Hyper Racer, and applies only to components replaced or modified during the engine build process, as defined by the selected engine build option.

Warranty coverage does not extend to the general condition, durability, service life, or performance of any engine components not explicitly replaced or modified by Hyper Racer.

1.1 Components Covered Under This Warranty

Subject to the selected engine build option, the following components may be covered only where replaced or modified by Hyper Racer:

- Upgraded valve springs
- Engine case studs
- Crankshaft main bearings
- Connecting rod big-end bearings
- Modified oil pickup and sump
- Water pump (seals replaced and anti-cavitation modifications applied)

No other engine components are covered under this warranty unless failure is proven to be the direct result of Hyper Racer's workmanship during assembly.

2. Engine Build Options

Hyper Racer offers multiple engine build options at the time of vehicle purchase. These options define the scope of components replaced during the engine build but do not alter the warranty duration, exclusions, or limitations outlined in this policy.

2.1 Option A — Core Reliability Rebuild

This option includes the following work only:

- Installation of new crankshaft main bearings
- Installation of new connecting rod big-end bearings
- Upgrade and installation of engine case studs
- Upgrade to Generation 1 valve springs

All other engine components remain original to the donor Hayabusa engine and are not replaced, refreshed, or reconditioned under this option.

2.2 Option B — Extended Internal Refresh

This option includes all work listed in Option A, plus replacement of the following internal components:

- Pistons

- Connecting rods
- Piston rings
- Valves

3. Warranty Application to Engine Build Options

Regardless of the engine build option selected, warranty coverage is strictly limited to defects in workmanship arising from the assembly, installation, or modification performed by Hyper Racer, and applies only to components replaced or modified during the engine build process.

This warranty does not cover defects inherent to original equipment manufacturer (OEM) or third-party supplied components, except where failure is proven to be the direct result of Hyper Racer's workmanship.

The warranty does not guarantee the service life, fatigue resistance, or performance of any engine components, whether newly installed or retained, except where failure is proven to be the direct result of Hyper Racer's workmanship.

Failures resulting from normal wear, fatigue, prior service history of donor engine components, or operating conditions are expressly excluded from warranty coverage.

Selection of an engine build option does not imply full engine reconditioning or warranty coverage beyond the components explicitly listed as replaced.

4. Warranty Term

This warranty is valid for a maximum of:

- Twenty (20) running hours, or
- Six (6) months from the date of first logged use,

whichever occurs first.

Running hours must be supported by data from the AIM Solo 2 DL system. Hyper Racer reserves the right to deny warranty claims if valid ECU or data logger information cannot be provided.

5. Approved Operating Conditions

To remain eligible for warranty coverage, the following operating requirements must be strictly observed:

- Oil: Castrol Edge Supercar 10W-60 only
- Oil Changes: As per Hyper Racer's recommended service intervals
- Coolant: Waterless coolant only (e.g. Liquid Intelligence)
- Fuel: 98-octane unleaded fuel only

6. Conditions That Void Warranty

This warranty is void if any of the following occur:

- Engine operation above 10,500 RPM
- Any over-rev event exceeding 10,800 RPM
- Oil starvation, incorrect oil grade, or failure to perform scheduled oil changes
- Use of incorrect coolant or non-compliant fuel
- Engine disassembly or tampering by non-authorized personnel
- Broken, missing, or tampered engine seals (used solely for warranty verification purposes)
- Failure to provide AIM Solo 2 DL data during a warranty claim

7. Warranty Claims Procedure

To initiate a warranty claim, the customer must:

- (a) Submit a written warranty claim via email to sales@hyperracer.com, including: customer name and contact details; engine number; vehicle chassis number; and a description of the reported issue.
- (b) Return the engine to Hyper Racer for inspection at the customer's cost.
- (c) Provide complete AIM Solo 2 DL data logs covering all engine operation.

Hyper Racer will assess the claim and, at its reasonable discretion, repair or replace components found to be defective under this policy. Labour and shipping costs are excluded. Warranty claims will not be considered unless initiated via email to sales@hyperracer.com within the applicable warranty period.

8. Exclusions

The following items are expressly excluded from warranty coverage:

- Clutch assembly and clutch actuation components
- Starter motor and alternator
- Gearbox and transmission components
- Sensors, wiring looms, and ECU hardware or software
- Failures resulting from racing incidents, accidents, misuse, or neglect
- Damage caused by third-party modifications or unauthorised tuning

9. General Terms

This warranty is non-transferable and applies only to the original purchaser. All warranty determinations, interpretations, and decisions are at the reasonable discretion of Hyper Racer. Nothing in this warranty excludes any rights that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law or, for international customers, any mandatory rights under the laws of their jurisdiction.

PART B — VEHICLE (CHASSIS & CAR) WARRANTY

10. Vehicle Warranty Scope

This vehicle warranty applies only to Hyper Racer X1 vehicles manufactured and supplied by Racing Cars International Pty Ltd ("Hyper Racer"). Vehicle warranty coverage is strictly limited to manufacturing defects in materials or workmanship of Hyper Racer manufactured components, present at the time of manufacture and identified under normal inspection and use.

This warranty does not constitute a performance guarantee, durability guarantee, or assurance of suitability for any specific competition, driving style, setup, or operating environment.

10.1 Components Covered Under Vehicle Warranty

Subject to inspection and approval by Hyper Racer, this warranty may apply only to manufacturing defects in the following Hyper Racer-manufactured components:

- Chassis and welded structural assemblies
- Suspension arms and fabricated brackets
- Steering components manufactured by Hyper Racer
- Pedal box and pedal assemblies manufactured by Hyper Racer
- Mounting brackets and fixtures supplied by Hyper Racer

Coverage applies only where a defect is proven to be the direct result of Hyper Racer's materials or workmanship at the time of manufacture.

10.2 Explicit Exclusions — Vehicle

The vehicle warranty does not cover:

- Normal wear and tear
- Fatigue-related failures
- Damage resulting from racing incidents, off-track excursions, impacts, or accidents
- Damage caused by improper setup, adjustment, or maintenance
- Damage caused by kerb strikes, bottoming, or contact with other vehicles

- Cosmetic defects, surface finishes, or appearance-related issues
- Alignment, setup, or handling characteristics
- Components supplied by third-party manufacturers
- Consumables including bearings, rod ends, brake components, bushings, joints, and fasteners
- Any component subjected to modification, repair, or welding by non-authorized personnel

10.3 Racing Use Acknowledgement

The Hyper Racer X1 is a purpose-built competition vehicle. The customer acknowledges that motorsport use inherently subjects the vehicle to high loads, vibration, fatigue, and risk of damage, and that component failure may occur without defect due to the nature of competition use. Failures resulting from these conditions are expressly excluded from warranty coverage.

11. Vehicle Warranty Term

The vehicle warranty is valid for a maximum of:

- Six (6) months from the date of first logged use, or
- Twenty (20) running hours,

whichever occurs first.

Hyper Racer reserves the right to determine warranty eligibility based on inspection, usage data, and service records.

12. Vehicle Warranty Claims Procedure

To initiate a vehicle warranty claim, the customer must:

- (a) Submit a written claim via email to sales@hyperracer.com, including: customer name and contact details; vehicle chassis number; and a description of the reported defect.
- (b) Return the vehicle or affected component to Hyper Racer for inspection at the customer's cost, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Hyper Racer will, at its reasonable discretion, repair or replace components found to be defective under this policy. Labour, transport, freight, and installation costs are excluded unless explicitly agreed in writing.

13. General Vehicle Warranty Terms

This vehicle warranty is non-transferable and applies only to the original purchaser. Hyper Racer reserves the right to deny any claim where damage is consistent with wear, fatigue, misuse, racing incidents, or improper operation. All determinations regarding warranty eligibility, interpretation, and remedy are at the reasonable discretion of Hyper Racer. Nothing in this warranty excludes any rights that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law or, for international customers, any mandatory rights under the laws of their jurisdiction.

14. Entire Agreement

This document constitutes the entire Engine and Vehicle Warranty Policy of Racing Cars International Pty Ltd (Hyper Racer) and supersedes any prior verbal or written representations.
